PLAN of DRIFT PILE RIVER RESERVE No. 150

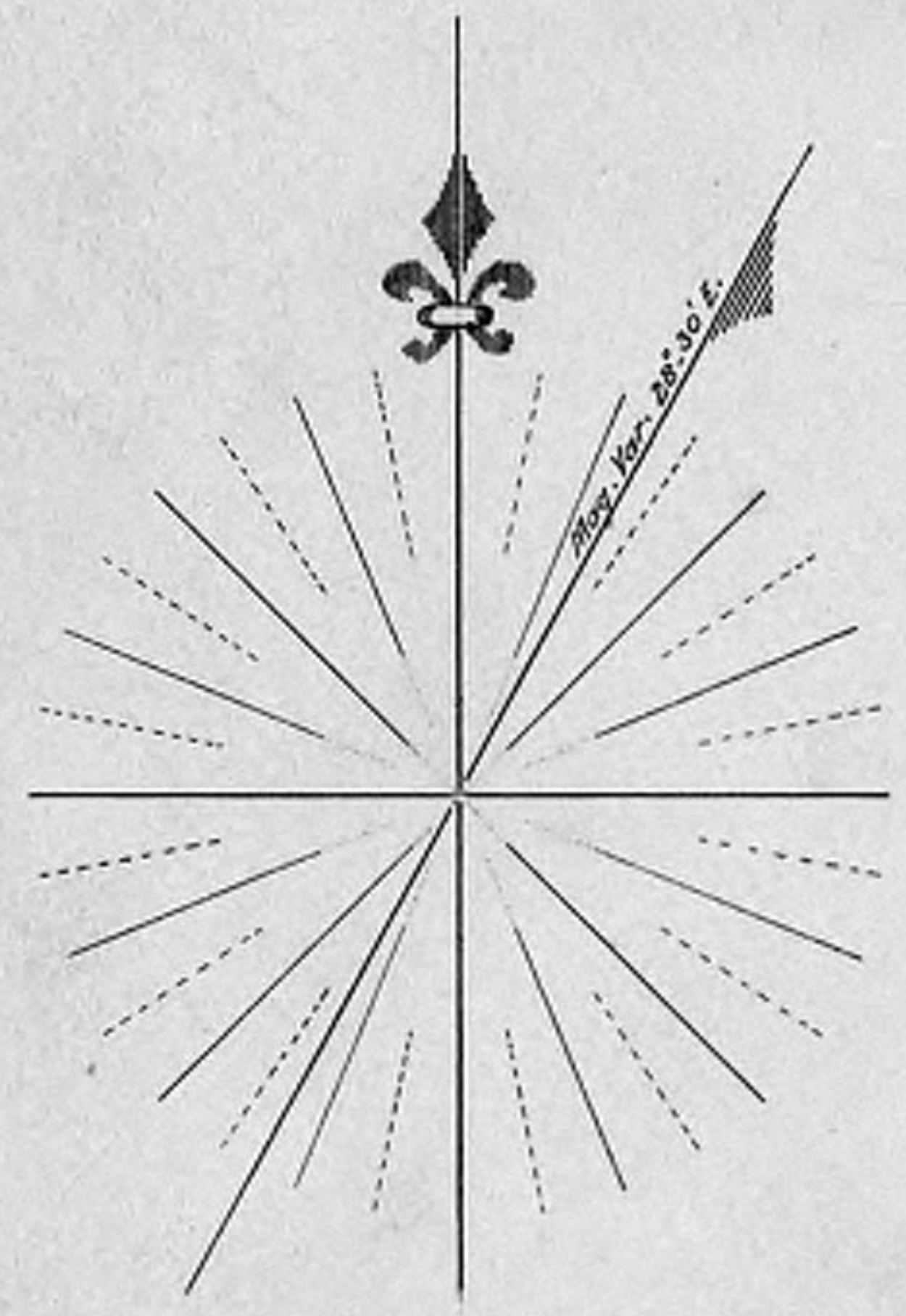
situated on the South shore of Lesser Slave Lake

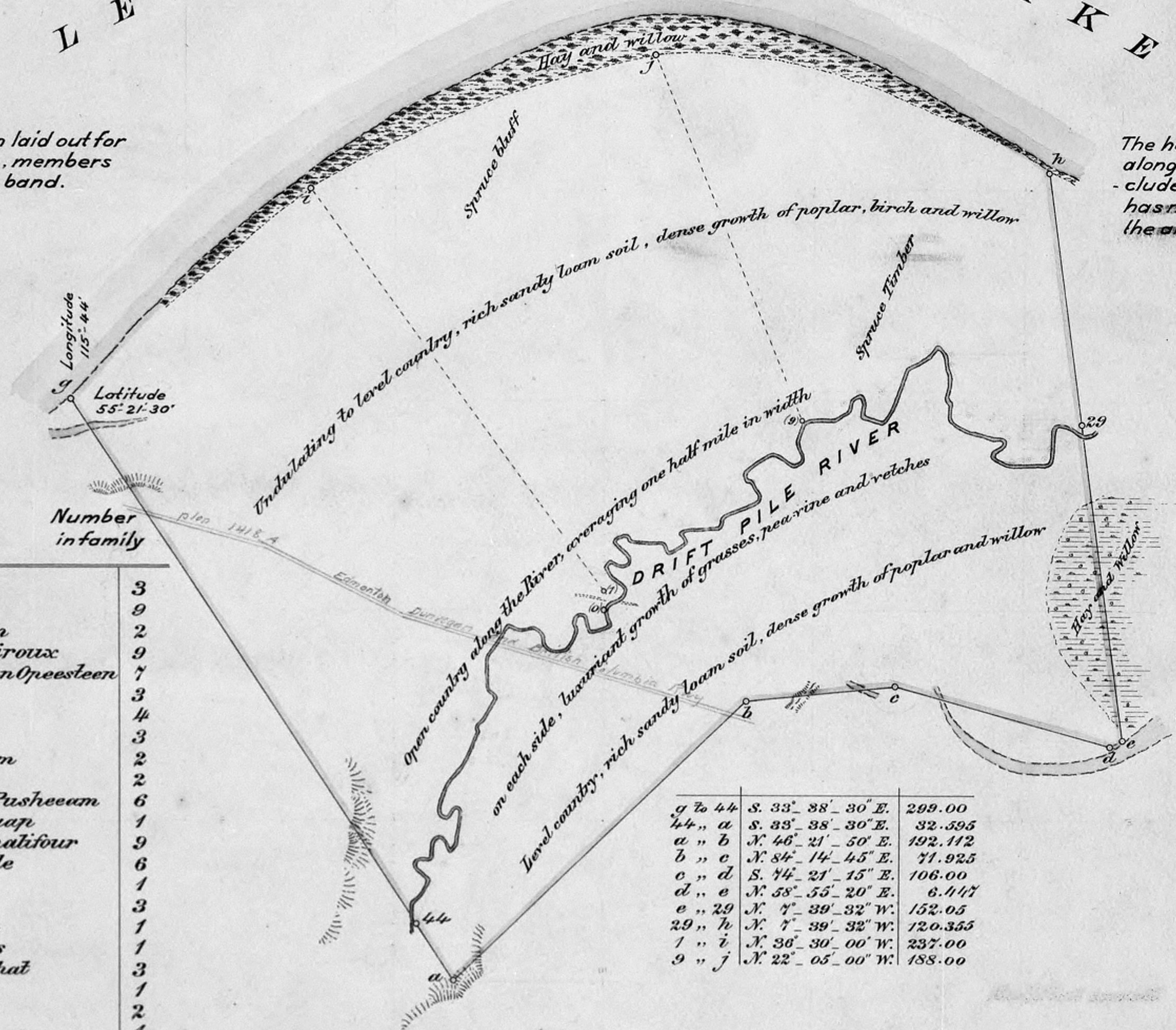
